## WELCOME SPACE URGENTLY NEEDS VOLUNTEERS:

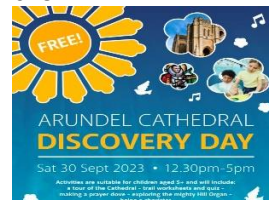
Our Thursday Welcome Space group, now back

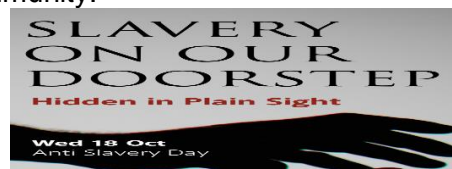
## ARUNDEL CATHEDRAL DISCOVERY DAY:
