Sunday of the Word of God. Pope Francis, in Apostolic Letter *Aperuit illis*, established in 2019 that the Third Sunday in Ordinary time was to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God. The day offers an important opportunity for people across our family of faith to celebrate, study and share the Word of God, with the theme for 2026: "The word of Christ dwells among you" (Col 3:16).

Franciscans announce a Jubilee Year for 2026. The Order of Franciscan Friars Minors has announced that 2026 will be a Franciscan Jubilee Year, with a Plenary Indulgence linked to the Jubilee. Francis of Assisi was born in Italy in 1181 or 1182. After a carefree youth, he converted and the Order of Friars Minor - commonly known as the Franciscans - began. A young woman, Clare of Assisi, wanted to share St Francis' choice of life, with the Order of the Poor Clares originating from her. Pope Leo writes: "In this age, marked by so many seemingly interminable wars, by internal and social divisions that create mistrust and fear, [St Francis] continues to speak. Not because he offers technical solutions, but because his life points to the authentic source of peace. The Franciscan vision of peace is not limited to the relations between human beings, but also embraces the whole of creation".
