**Week of Prayer for Christian Unity - 18th to 25th January.** This year the prayers and reflections for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity have been prepared by the faithful of the Armenian Apostolic Church, along with their brothers and sisters of the Armenian Catholic and Evangelical Churches. These resources draw upon centuries-old traditions of prayer and petitions used by the Armenian people, along with hymns

that originated in the ancient monasteries and churches of Armenia, some of which date as far back as the fourth century.

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2026 extends an invitation to draw upon this shared Christian heritage and to delve more deeply into our fellowship in Christ, which unites Christians worldwide. There will be lunchtime prayer sessions on Monday 19th January - Stonegate Church, Tuesday 20th January - Wadhurst (Carillon Cottage), Wednesday 21st January - Sacred Heart Church and Thursday 22nd January - Tidebrook Church.
