Father Raymond's Easter Message:

"He is not here; He has risen, just as He said."
(Matthew 28:6)

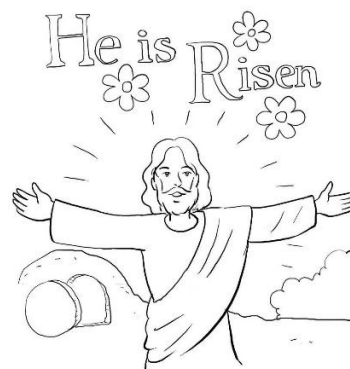
